We are currently installing more than 1,800 LF of 8", 6", and 4" water line and 29 valves (4" to 8") on the Tempe campus at Arizona State University (ASU). We are coordinating extensively with ASU and working nights when necessary to maintain access to Student Health Services and emergency vehicles. We are also installing a root barrier where the water line crosses close to mature trees, protecting the existing tree roots and preventing future disruption of the line. We rehabilitated a section of 24" Roosevelt Irrigation District irrigation line under the Union Pacific Railroad using ultraviolet light cured-in-place-pipe (UV CIPP).
