Water Line in Scottsdale

We are installing more than 3,200 LF of water line (16", 12", and 6") on Scottsdale Road from Princess Boulevard to Mayo Boulevard, including five manholes for air release valves and camera inspection. We carefully excavated and installed a segment of the water line under an existing double barrel box culvert, avoiding the need for a jack and bore. This work was completed as part of our Citywide Water Resources Infrastructure JOC contract for the City of Scottsdale. Visit our website for more project information and photos.


